



Arthur H. "Art" Banducci

October 9, 1933 - August 11, 2018

Arthur "Art" Banducci, 84, passed away Saturday following a brief illness at John Muir Medical Center in Concord surrounded by his family.

Art was born to Frank and Margie Banducci on October 9, 1933 in Richmond, CA and was a long-time resident of Benicia. He served in the U.S. Army and worked as a liquor salesman for more than 30 years. He loved fine food and wine, traveling, spending time with his family and was an avid antique car collector. Art was a member of the Horseless Carriage Club of America, served as Chairman of the Benicia Parks and Recreation Commission, member of the Benicia High School Boosters, and in earlier years was very involved in Benicia Little League and Benicia Pop Warner Football.

Art was preceded in death by his wife of 50 years, Doris on March 13, 2013; by his parents; his sister, Peggy; and by his brothers, Frank and Bill.

Survivors include his daughter Corrie (John) Core; son, Michael; grandchildren, Jesse Valentine, Justin Valentine and Kendall Core; and his good friend, Italian tenor, Pasquale' Eposito.

A memorial service will be held 11 AM Friday, September 7 at Passalacqua Funeral Chapel, 901 West 2nd St., Benicia. He will be laid to rest with his beloved wife Doris in a private ceremony at the Benicia City Cemetery.
