She is survived by her husband of 56 years (Bob), sons Rob (Carey) and Craig (Jenn) and grandchildren Christine, Robbie, Katie, Gabby, Raegan, Connor, and Sienna. She was preceded in death by her parents Greeta and Charles, and her brother Leonard.
