Roger Dodd, 88, of Benicia passed away Sunday in a local hospital following a brief illness. He was born in Nauvoo, Alabama to Newt & Daisy Dodd. He graduated from Lynn High School in Lynn, Alabama and was a veteran of the United States Navy.

Roger worked at the Benicia Arsenal, Army Missile Command in Huntsville, and Defense Contract Management in San Francisco. He retired with 31 years of service.

Roger was a member and past president of the Benicia Unified School District; President and member of Solano County School Board Association; Solano Community College dedication committee. He served on the Benicia Planning Commission, Benicia Civil Service Commission and past Chairman of March of Dimes.He was a member of the old 20/30 Club of Benicia and a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Benicia.

Roger often praised Ruby, his wife of 67 years for her loyal support, as well as his family for seeing that he had proper care during the last several years.

Roger was an avid fan of the Giants, 49ers, Stanford, Alabama, Benicia Panthers and girls softball both at the high school and college levels. He was a devoted grandfather and great grandfather and they were the light of his life.
