She moved to California as a young girl where she remained her entire life. She was raised in Pleasant Hill, graduating from Pleasant Hill High School in 1959 where she led the Rams Cheer Squad. She moved to Benicia in 1980 and later lived in Applegate and Lincoln. She passed away in Roseville after a short illness.

Arlene was a pioneer in the field of fitness, health and wellness. Her self-taught shrewd business skills benefited her greatly in her life. She was one of the original instructors of Jazzercise and later opened the first of her many successful businesses, Hi-Energy Aerobics, which was located in downtown Benicia.
