



Artur Avelino Cardoso

November 10, 1933 - February 17, 2023

Artur Avelino Cardoso, 89, longtime resident of Benicia passed away Friday at his home. He was born in Ribeira Seca, Sao Jorge, Acores and immigrated to the United States in 1961. He worked on several dairy farms across the Bay Area before settling in Benicia in 1966 where he worked on the Lopes dairy. Shortly after he met his wife to be Maria de Lourdes of 54 years. He then worked for Yuba Manufacturing as an overhead crane operator and later in environmental services for Kaiser Hospital in Vallejo before retiring after 23 years of service.

Artur enjoyed camping along the coast with family and friends. He loved boating and fishing on the ocean where he had a “sixth sense” in finding the fish. He was a passionate gardener. He grew many different vegetables especially white kale that he used in his famous kale soup. He liked old western movies, and attending the Holy Ghost Festivals in Benicia and throughout the Bay Area.

He is survived by his children Antonio (Ann) Cardoso and Lucia (Jim) Arruda; his brother Arlindo Cardoso and his granddaughter Josefina Cardoso.
