



Benjamin O. Querubin Jr.

April 27, 1937 - August 28, 2022

Benjamin Oliva Querubin Jr. passed away peacefully at the age of 85 years old, on Sunday, August 28th, 2022 in Kaiser San Leandro. He was born in Manila, Philippines on April 27, 1937.

After graduating from National University in the Philippines with two Engineering Degrees, in Mechanical Engineering and Industrial Engineering, he was recruited to work in Japan for a bit. Then, in 1967, with his wife and 11 month old baby, another job opportunity led him to Penticton, B.C. Canada, where he had his second child.

Hoping to advance his career even further, he moved his small family to Omaha, Nebraska. While living there, he earned an MBA at the University of Nebraska. He joined the Chess Club while attending UN, and eventually became a chess champion. After a few years, he then moved his family to Waukegan, Illinois, and then a few more years go by, and he was made an offer he couldn't refuse to move west to California. Finally, discovering Benicia, where he planted permanent roots since 1979.

He worked in the engineering discipline with various leadership roles for more than 30 years. During that time, he has worked for companies such as Proctor & Gamble, Abbot Labs, Bio Rad, Wells Fargo, BP Solar, Siemens, and Dynaflex to name a few. Eventually, he transitioned away from the engineering profession and obtained a Real Estate License, dabbled in the stock market as a day trader, and eventually settled on Accounting as his last profession of choice for more than 10 years until his eventual retirement from the work

force. He had a photographic memory, and could recall his memories as early as 3 years old, up until his very last breath.
