Brian M. Ferrucci, 41 of San Jose passed away peacefully Wednesday at Stanford Hospital. He was born in New Haven, Connecticut and lived in Benicia from 1980-1994. Brian earned his bachelor's degree in Aeronautical Engineering from Cal Poly and his master's from Santa Clara University in Mechanical Engineering. Since 2000, he has lived in San Jose.

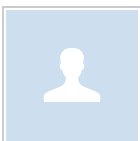
