David Allen Lidell, 68, was on a father-son road trip and passed away following a massive heart attack at the wheel and miraculously saved his son's life. David was a hero until the end. He was born in Marin County and lived for more than 22 years in Vallejo.

David was a 22 year veteran of the United States Navy, SCHTDV "E-8" most of those years as a deep sea diver and hull technician. He was a 100% Disabled Veteran, who served proudly for his country, in Vietnam, while there with his father-in-law. Following his retirement, he owned and operated North Bay Awards on Tennessee Street in Vallejo for nearly 20 years. Dave also was as assistant wrestling coach at Vallejo High School. He wrestled & played football for the USN in his early Navy years and a member of several organizations, including the Masonic Lodge #87, F.&A.M.; Vallejo Fleet Reserve Association #8; V.F.W Post 67. & the Native Sons of the Golden West. He was a history buff and a collector of World War II Memorabilia.

Dave is survived by Diane, his wife for over 45 years; his children Dean A. Lidell and Jason A. (Erin) Lidell; sisters Debby Lidell and Becky Lidell; brothers Dennis & Dwight Lidell; grandchildren John Robert Ready, whom Dave was so proud of John's service, 4 tours in Afghanistan, now seven in Italy as Army Infantry Jump Master E-6, & Olivia Andrade; great grandchild Nathaniel; his uncle Freddy Romagnolo; and cousins Sylvia, Cathy, Nancy &
