*I know how much she loved her Lord and her Family and Pets. And loved to cook special dinner's for her husband and friends. We talked a lot about food.*

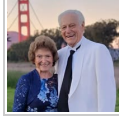
*I will truly miss her beautiful smile when ever I saw her.*
