Dianne Elizabeth Morris Yergovich (Daughter of the late Eugene Dwight Morris and Dorothy Henn Morris), 71, of Benicia passed away Sunday from a recurring illness. She was born in Chillicothe, Ohio, has been a Benicia resident since 1974.

Dianne's lifelong dedication to education, hard work and service to the community is evidenced by her achievements and career.
