A native of France he fought in WWII, joining the French Resistance on June 14, 1944 at the age of 19, he then joined the French Army in January 1945- February 1946. For much of his life, he worked as an airplane mechanic for Continental Airlines retiring after 25 years. He was a man of many talents, including speaking 4 languages fluently. 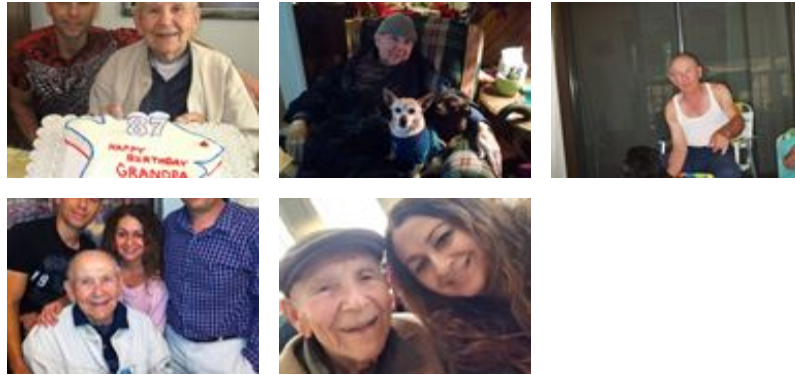
