Gracelee Chatman passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 3. She was born October 13, 1945 in Sampaloc, Manila to mother Milagros de Guzman and Father Charlie Chatman; Gracelee was the youngest of 3 children. She worked various Jobs in the Philippines before becoming a civilian employee at Camp John Hay in Baguio City, where she worked for many years. She came to live in California in the early 90s and settled in Benicia. Despite many health issues, she became a certified nursing assistant and found fulfillment caring for the elderly and children with special needs.
