Helen Genevieve Nelson passed away Tuesday in a local hospital following a brief illness, just months before her 100th birthday. She was born in Leaf Mountain, Minnesota and has lived in Benicia since 1942. She worked as a Teacher in a One-Room schoolhouse in Minnesota for several years before coming to California when she married her husband. She spent more than 17 years as an Avon Sales representative.

Helen was a 50 year member and past Worthy Matron of the Order of Eastern Star, a longtime member of the Community Congregational Church, a member of the Benicia PTA for many years and former Voting Precinct worker.

Helen is survived by her children Ethel Andrews, Roger (Nancy) Nelson & Virginia (Bill) Roberts; sisters Ina Sylvester & Bess Hamilton; brother Donald Rots, 7 grandchildren, 9 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandchild. She was preceded in death by her husband Donald G. Nelson in 1990.
