Hope M. McBride passed away peacefully at her home Sunday morning. She was born in Dallas, Texas and has been a Benicia resident since 2006. She was a housewife and a devoted mother.

Hope loved to travel and was an adventurer, taking her children with her to join her husband in Saudi Arabia in 1956. She spent many years volunteering for organizations such as the Women's Guild in Saudi Arabia, the Dhahran Senior Staff School, and the Women's Guild in Walnut Creek.
