James (Jim) B. Wallace, 69, of Benicia passed away Tuesday, May 12, 2015 in a local hospital following a brief illness. James was born and raised in Sacramento and has been a resident of Benicia since 1986. Jim served in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War, from 1969-1973.

Jim earned his bachelor's degree from San Jose State University, a master's degree from Louisiana Tech University, and a Ph.D. in Human Behavior from the United States International University in San Diego, CA. He worked as a Psychologist for more than 35 years and opened Human Behavior Associates in Benicia 26 years ago.

Jim's selfless and hardworking attitude were evident in the enjoyment he derived from volunteering in several service organizations; as a young man he was an Eagle Scout. Most recently he served with the Benicia Lions Club, the Solano County Agriculture Advisory Committee, the Open Government Committee of Benicia and the Benicia Educational Foundation. He loved his time coaching Benicia Youth Soccer, including his daughter and granddaughter's teams. Jim enjoyed traveling to Lake Tahoe and his hobby of home winemaking.

Jim is survived by Yolanda, his wife of 47 years, son Matthew (Theresa) Wallace; daughter Maurin (Jenny) Triplett; brother Stephen (Odile) Wallace;

mother-in-law Mary Calderon and his grandchildren Claire and Mateo Wallace and Marlowe James Triplett.

Visitation will be from 3-5 p.m. Sunday at Passalacqua Funeral Chapel, 901 W. Second St. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held 11 a.m. Monday at St. Dominic's Church, 475 E. I St., followed by a Celebration of Life reception at the Benicia Veteran's Memorial Hall at 1150 First St. Burial will be private at Vacaville-Elmira Cemetery.
