Paul is survive by his wife Margaret and three stepchildren and sister Juanita Davis of Garner, NC. Paul requested that no flowers be purchased for his memorial, but rather donations be made instead to the American Lung Association.

Paul attended college at Appalachian State University in Boone, NC where he earned a degree in business. He served his country in the U.S. Army after college taking station at the Presidio in San Francisco until being honorably discharged in 1956, after which he acquired his California teaching credential in business. Obtaining a position with Western railroad in 1956, Paul continued working in management positions with the railroad until his retirement from Union Pacific in 1986. After retiring, Paul taught at the Vallejo Adult School for 25 years, eventually becoming the chairperson of the Business Department. He was the driving force behind external support to his students in the form of scholarships, job shadowing and guest speakers. He also worked tirelessly with organizations and businesses in the community to assist students to achieve their employment goals. Affecting the lives of hundreds, Paul's warm humor, quick wit, grace and irresistible charm will be missed and cherished always by all of his family and friends.
