



Joel B. Fallon

June 16, 1931 - August 11, 2016

Joel B. Fallon, 85, of Benicia passed away Thursday in a local hospital following a battle with cancer. He was a 4th generation San Franciscan and has called Benicia his home since 1993.

He graduated from St. Ignatius High School in San Francisco and the University of the Philippines. Joel worked as an intelligence officer for the United States Army for more than 21 years and was a former member of the Joints Chief of Staff.

Joel was the first Poet Laureate of Benicia; former Vice President of Arts Benicia; a member of Friends of the Library and practiced Tai-Chi three times a week for more than 10 years. He taught english as a second language and was a mentor to Chinese speaking adults; he taught chess for more than 5 years at the Benicia Youth Center; he enjoyed sailing the waters of the Bay Area and was a Russian and Chinese linguist. During the summer between his junior and senior years in high school Joel worked as a merchant seaman. Joel is survived by Carolyn, his wife of 65 years; children Mary C. (Lance) Berquist, Michael (Beth) Fallon, Christopher (Rosa) Fallon, D'Arcy Fallon and Brian Fallon; 8 grandchildren, a great grandchild on the way and his pets Ulysses & Angel.

A Celebration of his Life will be held at a later date in December, details to follow.
