Leon D. "Pete" Ross passed away at his home Tuesday morning. He was a native of Travis, Texas and has lived in Benicia for almost 60 years. Pete was a proud graduate of Texas A&M University and a huge supporter and fan of the school. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War and was awarded the Silver Star.
