Malcolm is survived by his devoted and loving son Evan; brothers Mike & Marty Duvall; uncle to Dennis Welsh, Kimberly Walker & August Fenway Duvall, and loved by many cousins, and a host of dear longtime Benicia friends. He was called "Buddy" by his little friend Michaela Jones. He was
