Marvyn E. Siegal, 89, of Benicia passed away peacefully Wednesday following a long and valiant battle with Parkinson's disease. He was born and raised in New York City but later relocated to New Jersey, Massachusetts and Maryland, before settling in California in 1975, first in Los Angeles and for the past decade in Benicia.

Marvyn served in the United States Army during the Korean War from 1952-1954 as a 1st Lieutenant and member of the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers. After his military service, he obtained his Master of Science in Electrical Engineering from the University of Pennsylvania. For the bulk of his career, Marvyn applied his engineering and management skills to various electrical-communications projects, highlighted by his work on the Apollo program.

Marvyn was a huge fan of the professional New England area sports teams, including the Patriots, Bruins, Celtics and his beloved Boston Red Sox. During healthier times, he enjoyed golfing, photography, boating, snow skiing, and reading. He also loved crossword puzzles, completing the New York Times crossword puzzle daily.

Marvyn is survived by Susan, his beloved wife of 64 years; children Floyd (Yna), Dia (Brent), and Paul; sister Estelle; grandchildren Jamie (Jacob), Aaron, and Mandy; and great grandchildren Opal and Ayla.

Private graveside services with Military Honors will be held at Sacramento Valley National Cemetery, Dixon, CA later in the Month. The family prefers donations to either The Parkinson's Foundation or The Michael J. Fox Parkinson's Research Foundation.
