



## Rev. Mary Linda Goshert-Ekenstam

January 4, 1944 - June 11, 2025

Mary Linda Ekenstam, born January 4, 1944 in Orange, California to Richard and Velma Foster.

passed into the larger life on June 11, 2025.. She lived with the family in Midway City,

California until her graduation with a B.A. from California State University-Long Beach and her

marriage in 1965 to John Goshert. She earned an MA in Library Science from California State

University-Fullerton and worked in the public libraries of Pomona,CA and Gilroy, CA. She and

husband John had two sons, John Charles and Michael James.

Mary was called to the Episcopal ministry and entered the Church Divinity School of the Pacific

in Berkeley, earned the degree of MDiv and was ordained to the ministry on February 2, 1980.

After three years as Assistant Priest at St. Martin's Episcopal Church in Davis, CA and the

death of husband John, she was called as Rector to St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Benicia, CA.

She subsequently served parishes in Morgan Hill, Long Beach, Santa Maria, and Claremont, all

in California. In retirement after 2011, she served several churches as a Priest

in Charge or as  
a Sunday Supply priest in the Episcopal Diocese of Northern California.  
Mary had enrolled in the seminary before the national Episcopal church had  
approved the  
ordination of women to the priesthood. This policy changed during her third  
year in seminary.  
Her call to serve as Rector at St. Paul's in Benicia gave her the distinction of  
being first ordained  
woman to lead an Episcopal congregation in the Western United States. Her  
work as a priest  
was marked by empathetic leadership, deep scholarship, and compassion for  
all people.  
She is survived by her sister, Jackie Reicks, brother Richard Foster and wife  
Sandy Foster,  
sons John Goshert and wife Cindy Goshert, Michael Goshert and wife  
Danielle Goshert and  
their children Ruby Goshert and Vaughn Goshert and her husband of 14  
years, Gene  
Ekenstam. She had five nephews and nieces; Gene's three children and four  
grandchildren  
complete her extended family. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. on  
Saturday, June 21 at  
St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Benicia..
