



Millicent E. "Millie" Duvall

January 18, 1967 - June 5, 2015

Millicent E. Duvall passed away Friday night in a local hospital surrounded by family & close friends following a courageous battle with cancer. Millie, a life long resident of Benicia, California graduated from St. Dominic School and St. Vincent Ferrer High School Class of 1985. She was employed by St. Patrick-St. Vincent High School for the past 18 years, most recently as Director of Development. Millie will be remembered for her strength, generous heart, great sense of humor and undeniable wit. She was a devoted and loving daughter, sister, sister-in-law, and aunt. Her passion and commitment to her family, friends, faith, as well as to the SPSV community, both past and present, will be sorely missed.

Millie was a longtime member of a variety of both Catholic and Benicia associations: St. Dominic's Church, Holy Ghost Society, Soroptimist, Chamber of Commerce and the Benicia Bocce League.

Millie is survived by her brothers: Michael (Katherine), Martin and Malcolm Duvall, nephews: Dennis Welsh, Gus Duvall, Evan Duvall and her niece, Kimberly Walker. She was preceded in death by her sister Margaret "Peggie" Duvall Welsh.

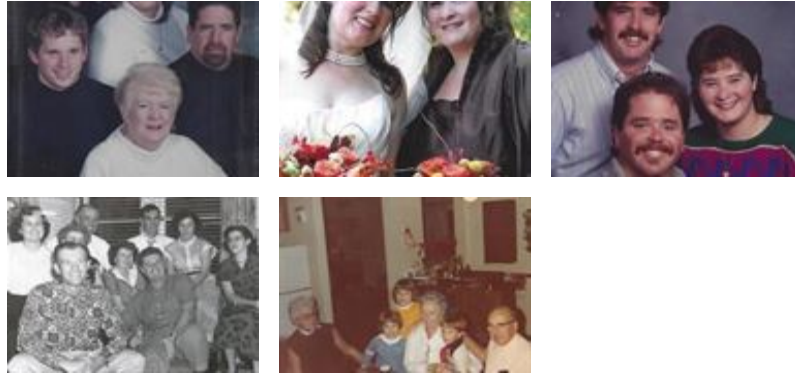
