



## Nancy S. Davis

Nancy S. Davis passed away on Saturday at her home in Walnut Creek. She was born in New York City, raised in San Francisco, and graduated from Lowell High School. At age 17, Nancy embarked on her nursing career. She lived in Rhode Island, Alaska, and San Diego before settling in Benicia with her husband Douglas C. Davis, where she lived for over 40 years before moving to Walnut Creek in 2004.

Nancy served as a nurse in the United States Air Force, obtaining the rank of Captain. Following her honorable discharge, she continued her registered nursing career. She was a graduate of St. Mary's College in Moraga with a bachelor's degree in Nursing.

Nancy is survived by her children Michelle Denise McDonogh, Louise Corinne Rummel, Anthony Gardner Davis, her stepchildren Carmel Leigh Nalani Tosaki, Keith Mowry Kealii Davis, Lisa Gayle Nohealani Solook, 16 grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, and her best friend and companion Valentino Nivolo of Rossmoor. She was preceded in death by her husband Cmdr. Douglas C. Davis, USN (Ret.) in 2002.
