



## Nancy M. Gigliotti

Nancy Marie Gigliotti passed away peacefully on April 15, 2026, in Vallejo, California, at the age of 87.

Born on July 29, 1938, in San Francisco, California, Nancy was raised in the city she loved and attended St. Paul's High School. She met her husband of 61 years, Tom, and raised four sons in the City. She went on to enjoy a remarkable career spanning more than 30 years, working with both the San Francisco Giants and the San Francisco 49ers, where she was known for providing exceptional hospitality to VIP guests. Her warmth, professionalism, and welcoming spirit left a lasting impression on all who had the pleasure of meeting her.

Nancy was an active member of both Corpus Christi Parish and Archbishop Riordan High School in San Francisco. After moving to Benicia in 2005, she was a devoted member of St. Dominic's Catholic Church and the Benicia Senior Center. Nancy gave generously of her time at St. Dominic School serving lunches to the school children and at St. Paul's Food Bank serving meals to the community. She was always eager to lend a helping hand

knowing that friendships would be made along the way.

Nancy found great joy in the simple pleasures of life, especially camping trips in the Sierra Mountains, Mount Shasta and especially with friends and family at the Eel River Campground in Mendocino County. More than anything, Nancy cherished time spent with her family—particularly her beloved grandchildren and her daughters-in-law, who brought her immense pride and happiness.

Nancy is survived by her sons: Rich and his wife Kathy; Mike and his wife Dania; Tom and his wife Cindy; and Steve and his wife Heidi. She is also survived by her ten grandchildren: Sarah, Tony, Samantha, Jacob, Kimberlee, Amie, Justin, Emily, Nikki, and Antonio.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Tom, who passed away in November 2018.

Vigil services will be held 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 10th at Passalacqua Funeral Chapel. A Memorial Mass will be held on Thursday, June 11 at 11:00 a.m. at St. Dominic's Catholic Church in Benicia with A Celebration of Life to follow in the Parish Hall.
