Paul Duwayne Southall passed away at Kaiser Vallejo Medical Center on November 24th, 2024 at the age of 71. Paul was preceded in death by his father John Southall, mother Sarah Southall (Ferguson), brother John Southall, wife Dorothy Southall (Lewis) and his son Jason Southall.
