After spending 12 years active duty with the United States Air Force, he continued his career as a U.S. Civil Servant, while serving in the USAR and subsequently the California State Military Reserves where he was promoted to Col. and Brevet Brigadier General.

BG Lundin spent many years serving both his nation, where he was awarded many decorations and commendations as well as numerous organizations and local communities.
