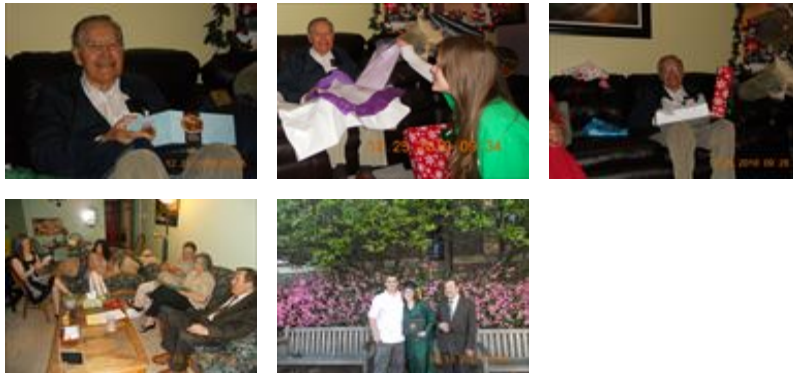
“ Grandpa,
