Shirley "Ray" Eggman, 81, passed away suddenly in Stockton on Monday. He moved the family to Turlock in 1974 where he farmed almonds and realized his dream of becoming a commercial Beekeeper. Ray was most at home in a bee-yard working with his "Little-Darlings." His strong bees were famous for pollinating crops and producing some of the finest honey in the state. In his lifetime Ray was a loving husband, wonderful father and fun-loving grandfather. He was a generous, kind man whom always had a smile on his face and would always take the time to say "Hello" to friends and strangers alike. Ray was a veteran of the National Guard and United States Air Force.

Ray was survived by his children Assemblymember Susan Eggman, her partner Rene Hall, Michael Eggman and spouse Stacey, Ellen Kisiday and spouse Joseph; his grandchildren Hanalei, Saylor, Matyas, Alayna & Emelia and his three brothers Gene, Artith and Max.
