Thelma M. Ivey, 102, passed away at her home after a brief illness. She was born in Selma, CA, lived in Dinuba, CA for several years and was a resident of Piedmont from 1952-1998 before moving to Benicia.

Thelma was a 4th generation Californian. Her grandparents, the Elders were part of the second Donner Party and her ancestors, the Parkers, fought in the Revolutionary War. Thelma's great grandparents, the Greenwoods, came from New York by covered wagon. Thelma's grandfather and his brothers fought in the Civil War, and legend has it that they fought on opposite sides. Thelma's father fought in the Mexican American War.

Thelma is survived by her son, Dr. Robert Madsen of Benicia. She was preceded in death by her husband Dean Ivey in 1965 and her son Gary Madsen in 2009.
