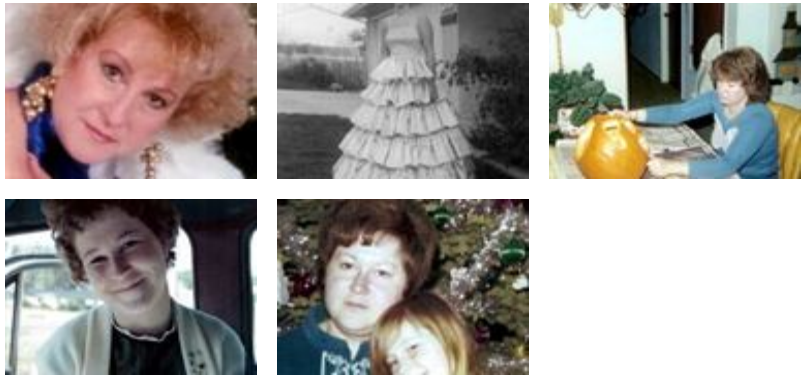


“ Dear Randy & Cat,
